Team Derby is a run club which collects and holds personal data belonging to both individuals and occasionally, organisations. Team Derby Runner is committed to data security and the fair and transparent processing of personal data. This Privacy Policy sets out how we will treat the personal data which you provide to us in compliance with applicable data protection law and in particular the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR).

How Team Derby Runner obtains your personal data:

Team Derby Runner will only store personal data belonging to individuals or organisations with their consent. Consent is ordinarily gained either in writing, with a signature against a consent statement, via telephone call or when an individual signs up for membership of Team Derby Runner.

We do not collect any personal data through any automatic website function unless the website contact form is used. In this case, personal information is used only for the purpose of the website enquiry.

Data will continue to be stored with relevant bodies as explained in this document, for future communications until a Team Derby Runner Membership is terminated.

Who do we share your personal data with?

England Athletics and any other racing body where Team Derby Runner have representation, any race day staff unless included via registration forms and any emergency services or medical treatment personal should it be required.

Where do we store your personal data and how is it protected?

We take reasonable steps to protect your personal data from loss or destruction. We also have procedures in place to deal with any suspected data breach. We will notify you and any applicable regulator of any suspected data security breach where we are legally required to do so. Unfortunately, the transmission of data through the internet is not completely secure.

Team Derby Runner uses SSL encryption.

An SSL certificate is a digital certificate that authenticates a website's identity and enables an encrypted connection. We add an SSL certificate to our website to secure any online transactions and keep customer information private and secure.

We store personal details electronically using an online membership and email database.

Where any personal data are stored on our own computer hard drives, such data will only be stored on machines which are not part of any sharing network and which are kept secured by continuously updated internet security software.

Rights:

Under the GDPR you have various rights with respect to our use of your personal data:

Right to Access:

You have the right to request a copy of the personal data that we hold about you by contacting us at the email or postal address given below. Please include with your request information that will enable us to verify your identity. We will respond within 30 days of the request. Please note that there are exceptions to this right. We may be unable to make all information available to you if, for example, making the information available to you would reveal personal data about another person, if we are legally prevented from disclosing such information, or if your request is manifestly unfounded or excessive.

Right to Rectification:

We aim to keep your personal data accurate and complete. We encourage you to contact us using the contact details provided below to let us know if any of your personal data is not accurate or changes, so that we can keep your personal data up to date.

Right to Erasure:

You have the right to request the deletion of your personal data where, for example, the personal data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected, where you withdraw your consent to processing, where there is no overriding legitimate interest for us to continue to process your personal data, or your personal data has been unlawfully processed. If you would like to request that your personal data is erased, please contact us using the contact details provided.

Right to Object:

In certain circumstances, you have the right to object to the processing of your personal data where, for example, your personal data is being processed on the basis of legitimate interests and there is no overriding legitimate interest for us to continue to process your personal data or if your data is being processed for direct marketing purposes. If you would to object to the processing of your personal data, please contact us using the contact details provided below.

Right to restrict processing:

In certain circumstances you have the right to request that we restrict the further processing of your data. This right arises where, for example, you have contested the accuracy of your personal data and we are verifying the information. Where you have made any request of us under your GDPR rights, you may request that we restrict processing whilst we are ourselves processing your request.

Right to Data Portability:

In certain circumstances, you have the right to request that some of your personal data is provided to you, or to another data controller, in a commonly used, machine-readable format.

Please note that GDPR sets out exceptions to all the above rights. If we are unable to comply with your request due to an exception we will explain this to you in our response.
